Now in our sixth year, we've focused on strengthening our platform and expanding our reach, and the results have been inspiring. This year, we facilitated 19% more equipment exchanges than the year before, a clear reflection of the growing trust and engagement within our community.

Nearly 500 pre-owned medical items found new homes through AssistList, helping individuals and families access the essential equipment they need. And this figure only accounts for reported exchanges, underscoring the broader, often unseen impact our platform continues to make in the community. 




## FINANCIAL SNAPSHOT

Our organization remains financially strong, with a solid foundation that enables sustainable growth and continued impact in the communities we serve.




Total: \$3,318 CAD
